The virtual reality version will be available later in the year. The original Crysis broke several new ground for the gaming industry, including the use of 3D graphics, AI, and more than 100 weapons. But the game's developers have since moved on to building more ambitious titles that both push the hardware of the PlayStation 4 and Xbox

One and wowed players with stunning visuals. Since it was first released in 2007, the original Crysis has sold more than 2.4 million copies and earned more than 20 game-of-the-year awards and accolades. The series also expanded to other platforms, including PC, PS3, and Xbox 360. Crysis 3 marked the first game in the series that would eventually be released on PlayStation 4, Xbox One, and Windows PC. The original Crysis is available for \$5.99 on both the Xbox Live and PlayStation Network. The “fully remastered” version of Crysis 3 Remastered is available for \$29.99 on the PlayStation Network.
